George Mason University Undergraduate Tuition Rates Spring 2014

Education Resource Fee: All students are charged a mandatory per-semester fee, \$100 for seven credits or more, and \$60 for less than seven credits, which allows Mason to maintain essential support services for both full and part-time students.

Undergraduate New Student Fee: This is a mandatory, non-refundable, one-time fee. The fee is charged to the account of every newly admitted, degree-seeking student at the time of registration, regardless of orientation attendance or enrollment status. The new student fee is \$275.00 for undergraduate students and \$210.00 for transfer students.

International Student Health Insurance: Health insurance is required for all F-1 and J-1 visa holders. Students are required to purchase the policy arranged by the university, unless exempted by the Student Health Insurance Office. Health insurance fees are deducted from all payments received by the university before funds are applied to tuition or other charges. Failure to make this payment may result in cancellation of classes. For exemption criteria and due dates, see the University Catalog or contact the Student Health Insurance Office in SUB I, 703-993-2827.
